

QUALIFYING PROJECT TYPES

Awards for the Built Environment

RESTORATION

Returning a building to its former appearance at a specific period of its history, removing later features and reconstructing missing features.

ADAPTIVE USE

Returning a building to a state of utility, while retaining the historic character of the building.

PRESERVATION

Recognizing activity that extends the life or utility of a historic resource.

INFILL / ADDITION

Adding to a building, complex or neighborhood in a manner which retains the character of the original building(s).

NEIGHBORHOOD IDEOLOGY

A structure or building that contributes significantly to the character of a neighborhood.

UNIQUE RESOURCES

Recognizing the rehabilitation, improvement or restoration of historic or natural resources, such as engineering works and landscapes.

PUBLIC BUILDING INTERIOR

Restoring or rehabilitating to the highest standards a historic space or spaces that are available for viewing by the general public on a regular basis.
