The San Antonio Conservation Society represents over 1500 citizens who support the conservation of our natural, built and cultural heritage. We invested \$50,000 in the rehabilitation of the Hays Street Bridge. This bridge, which serves as an icon of the near East Side community, is a public space that must be accessible to all.

The Society has previously advocated for the preservation of sightlines to and from the bridge. The current development proposal has a modest setback from the bridge, but we would urge the creation of a larger space that would help preserve views of the bridge. We also suggest that the vacant land adjacent to the bridge be either donated as a park or preserved through a conservation easement to ensure that the bridge remains unencumbered.
