1920s

1925 – The Conservation Society and the Alamo Mission Chapter of the DRT co-sponsor a public meeting, urging the City to purchase the remaining privately-owned property adjoining the Alamo church.



Alamo Plaza, c. 1916 - Commercial buildings, like the Oakland Motor Co., crowded close to the Alamo (upper left).

1926 – Society purchases the last original doors to Mission San José's granary to protect the brass medallions on them from souvenir hunters.



1929 - Conservation Society begins purchasing San José Mission Granary property.
