Job Description
JUNIOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

The purpose of this committee is to coordinate activities of the Junior Associates and act as liaison between the Junior Associates and the Board of Directors.

The Junior Associate Members purport “to inspire and create an interest in local history and its preservation. The Juniors assist the parent association in events and programs when called upon.”

Junior Associate Members shall be governed by their own bylaws, elect their own officers and conduct their affairs under the name of the Junior Associate Members of the San Antonio Conservation Society. The Junior Associate Members may be called to participate in additional Society activities as directed by the San Antonio Conservation Society President. A Junior Associate Member, upon attainment of age of eighteen (18) may become an Associate Member of the Society by making a written application to the Membership Committee.

DUTIES OF THE CHAIRMAN

1. Appoint members to the committee and presents to President for approval. Assign committee duties to the members.
2. Keep the President informed of all meetings and activities of the committee.
3. Works with Staff Liaison to coordinate activities of committee.
4. Assist in the development of programs and projects relative to the purpose of the Conservation Society, and invite other youth organizations to participate.
5. Coordinate the participation of the Junior Associate members in the King William Fair Parade and the Pilgrimage to the Alamo activities as representatives of the Society.
6. Maintain in the office a file of Junior Associate activities, as well as a current list of all officers and members.
7. Juniors will design and execute an annual community project, intended to “inspire and create an interest in local history and its preservation.”
8. File a final report of the committee’s activities before the June general membership meeting.
