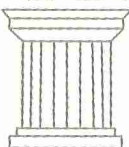
The San Antonio Conservation Society agrees with the OHP staff recommendation of denying the proposed design for the building located at 434 Sherman. It lacks compatibility with the design of surrounding homes in the Dignowity Hill Historic District. While there is clearly an attempt at imbuing the building with regional architectural interest, the design is both out of scale with the surrounding buildings and lacking the appropriate architectural forms of the district.
