It reflects the history of the once vital Mexican American neighborhood but was relegated to notoriety because it was the location of the City's red-light district. Its so-called "house of ill repute," which generated significant income for the City, subsequently housed the Catholic Church's ministry to the working-class Mexican American community, especially to women and children.

The Westside has fewer landmarks than other parts of the city. This is not because its history is less rich, but because its historic buildings receive less protection.
